PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project will include rehabilitating the precast bridge on Highway No.23 C.S. 23-04 over Carrot River, approximately 11 km south of the Town of Carrot River.

PROJECT DETAILS

- The Ministry is planning to rehabilitate the bridge mentioned above from July 4th to August 19th, 2022.
- 13 existing deteriorated concrete precast girders will be replaced along with the south abutment cap.
- The Northern Bridge Crew is expected to begin work on July 4th, 2022, and is expected to complete the project by August 19th, 2022.
- Regular traffic will be accommodated by one lane of the bridge during staged construction. Over width traffic more than 4.2m will have to take a local over-dimensional route.
- The over-dimensional route will be Highway 690 and Highway 35.
- The public can expect minor delays and disruptions to their normal schedules and 2 hours delays on some days when switching the girders, as the bridge will be single lane and controlled by traffic signals. The traffic signals will be inspected and maintained by qualified personnel throughout the duration of the project.
- The bridge will be a maximum of 4.2 meters in width. Motorists will be required to adhere to a 60 km/hr speed limit within the construction zone.
